## MEMBER AGREEMENT:

I agree to pick up produce at the agreed upon place and time. If produce is not picked up and prior arrangements have not been made, I understand that week's share will be forfeit.

I will make prior arrangements for vacation dates at least one week in advance. I understand that the farmers reserve the right, based on availability, to determine the possibility for make-up dates, or that I may donate my share for that week to a food-relief organization of their choice. I may also make arrangements for a friend to pick up my share in my absence.

If I opt for on-farm pickup, I agree to respect the property and livestock of the farmer. I will not bring dogs to the farms, and if I bring children, they will be supervised. I will park in designated areas. I understand that membership does not entitle me to visit the farm unannounced.

I understand that variety of produce received depends on growing conditions that vary from season to season and that the risks and benefits of the harvest are shared.
